Question (a): The current developments of the Chandipur Fishing Harbour Project in Balasore;

Reply: Information not available with the institute.

Question (b): The timeline by which the harbour project is expected to be completed / fully functional;

Reply: Information not available with the institute.

Question (c): Whether the Government has evaluated the potential socio-economic benefits from the development of the Chandipur Fishing Harbour Project:

Reply: The Central Institute of Coastal Engineering for Fishery (CICEF), Bengaluru conducted economic investigations during August, 2010.

Question (d): If so, the details thereof;

Reply: The fishing harbour will accommodate a fishing fleet of 550 vessels comprising of 300 numbers of 14 m trawlers, 150 numbers of 12 m trawlers and 100 numbers of 9 m motorised/traditional crafts.

The project would give employment to 4,300 sea-going fishermen in 550 MFVs and about 1,300 persons in shore-based establishments, distribution and marketing of fish and crustacean products. Thus, 5,600 persons would be benefited directly in the fishing industry from project implementation, apart from the

indirect benefits that would accrue as a result of developmental efforts.

The income earned by the fishermen would be of the order of Rs. 1,675 lakhs, whereas the net income earned by vessel-owners after meeting provisions for fishing vessel maintenance, fishing gear maintenance, interest and payment of instalment dues towards loans etc., aggregate to Rs. 560.00 lakhs.

The project would contribute substantially to increase the fish and crustacean supplies to both domestic and export markets. The total sale of fish and crustacean products would amount to 20,307 t valued at Rs. 25,602.63 lakhs. Of this, the export of frozen crustaceans is 1970 t, valued at Rs. 9,056.19 lakhs.
